Construction Camp
July 8 - 12

GETTING STARTED

1 SIGN-UP FOR CAMPS!

- Complete the sign-up form on our website:
hazelwoodseattle.org/summercamps
- You must register each child separately.

3 PAYMENT

Parents sign-up and pay for weekly camps. Camps run 5 days a week. (There are no sibling discounts)

- **Full Day 8:30-4: \$425 per week**
- **Half Day 8:30-1: \$300 per week**

Payment is due **1 week** after date of registration via ProCare.

2 CHECK YOUR EMAIL

- You will receive a follow-up email confirming the camps within 48 hours.
- We use ProCare for registration and payments. If you are not currently in the ProCare system, you will receive an email link to complete registration and set up payment.

CHANGE OF PLANS?

No problem! You may cancel within 3 weeks of the first day of the camp for a full refund.

Camp Information



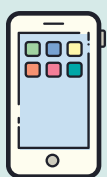
Location: Camps are held at Hazelwood Preschool located in the UCC Fauntleroy Church at 9140 California Ave SW (98136). Classrooms face the parking lot. Camp will utilize the indoor classrooms, playground, and Fauntleroy Park trails.



Age Guidelines: Hazelwood Summer Camps enroll children 2 to 7 years. Campers will be divided into separate groups for activities depending on age.



Hours and Late Pick-Up Policy: Please drop your children off between 8:30 – 9:00AM. Half Day pick up by 1:00PM. Full Day pick up by 4:00PM. Because we want to respect the time of our staff, repeated late pick-ups after 10 minutes may result in the removal of the participant from the program with no refund. **There is no aftercare available during summer.**



ProCare and Communication: If you are new to Hazelwood, you will be sent a link to download the ProCare App. This is also where you will register your child, set up payment, and upload any forms. It is important that all parents/guardians download the app because this is how you will sign your camper in and out, communicate with the school during the day, and receive alerts if we need to get ahold of you. If you do not have a smartphone, please let the camp leaders know and they will sign your camper in and out for you.



Payment and Refunds: Each camp runs for 1 week and cost \$425 for Full Day and \$300 for Half Day. Payments will be paid through the ProCare Site 1 week after registration. You may cancel 3 weeks prior to the first day of camp to receive a full refund. There is no refund less than 3 weeks since we have already purchased supplies and hired staff.



Forms/Proof of Vaccine: If you are new to Hazelwood, you will be sent a link to register into our system on ProCare site. The form must be filled out to keep your spot and will be good for the entirety of their time at Hazelwood. All children must also have proof of receiving a covid vaccination unless medically exempt in which case, an official letter from a health care professional explaining the exemption must be provided. We are not admitting non-vaccinated children at this time unless medically exempt. Children who do not have their forms signed will not be admitted until staff have received them.



Medical Needs/Allergies: Hazelwood Camp Leaders are not permitted to administer medication to program participants, unless authorized by both parent and doctor. If you would like to submit an EpiPen or other needed medication, please fill out the appropriate sections of the registration form and you will be sent a Medication Release Form. In the event of a medical emergency, Hazelwood Leaders will administer first aid, CPR, and rescue efforts in the best interest of the child. Parents will be contacted immediately if care is administered. **Please note, we are NOT a nut free school.**



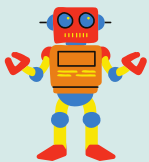
Sunscreen: Please apply sunscreen prior to the start of each camp day. Teachers will have extra on hand for reapplying throughout the day.



Lunch/Snacks: Hazelwood will be providing an early snack at arrival (and afternoon snack for full day campers) of fruit, protein, and grain as well as plenty of water throughout the day. Please pack a lunch and labeled water bottle for your child each day. Lunches will be stored inside the classrooms and out of the sun. Please no glass containers, soda, gum, or candy.



Dress Code: Children should dress appropriately for the activities scheduled and weather including good footwear for running and playing outdoors. All shoes must be closed-toed and have a back on them (no slip-ons or flip-flops). Please no lace up shoes unless they can tie them on their own.



Diapers, Wipes, and Personal Belongings: Please put your child's name on all articles of clothing, water bottles, bags, etc. If your child is still using diapers/pull-ups, please pack enough plus wipes for your child each day or bring a bag of a week's worth on the first day. Children should not bring toys, electronic devices, jewelry, money, or any possession of value with them to the camp.



Nap Time: Full Day campers may opt in for nap time which is between 1 and 3pm. If you are new to Hazelwood, please make sure to select that option on the registration forms and supply a blanket and pillow/comfort item each week. Those items will be kept at school and sent home on Friday.

BEFORE CAMP BEGINS CHECK LIST

NEW TO HAZELWOOD:

- After you sign-up, look for confirmation email and follow link to register on ProCare and:
 - Download app and turn notifications on.
 - Make an account.
 - Complete registration form and fee. The fee will then be applied to your camp costs.
 - Upload official proof of child's Covid vaccination.
- Look out for invoice email. As long as your payment information is correct, payments will be auto deducted out of your account 1 week after you register so no need to do anything.
- Complete medication forms if requested.

RETURNING TO HAZELWOOD:

- Look out for both confirmation and invoice emails.
- Registering a new sibling? You will be sent a link to register them as well. The registration fee will be applied to your camp costs.

- BLANKET AND OPTIONAL PILLOW/COMFORT ITEM FOR THOSE NAPPING

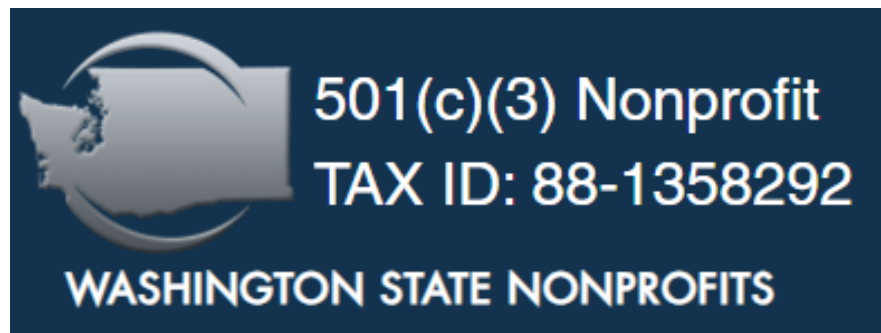
